

Khpal Kor Foundation is a reputable non- profit organization registered under the Voluntary Social Welfare Agencies (Registration and Control) Ordinance 1961 (XLVI of 1961) with Department of Social Welfare Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. It has also been granted approval as NPO (Non-Profit Organization) under section 2 (36) of the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001 read with Rule 212 & 214 of the Income Tax Rules by the Commissioner Inland & Revenue Zone -II at Regional Tax Office Peshawar. The history of Khpal Kor Foundation dates back to October, 1996 when a group of spirited scouts namely Swat Scouts Open Group with support from local philanthropists laid its foundation to look after orphan children of the community. Starting with only five children it has now turned into a huge success and is imparting free education along with boarding & health care facilities to scores of orphan children from across the region. It has separated campuses for boys & girls providing education from Nursery to Fsc Level (12 standard) and also make arrangement in relation to higher education for orphan, poor and talented students at university level.

Our Vision

A society where no child indulges into criminality due to obsence of appropriate care.

Our Mission

To create conditions for children especially orphans to live normal life and attain their full potential as normal citizen of the country.

Our Motto

In the year 2015, Khpal Kor Foundation took laudable initiative by opening a Swat Evening College and admitted 80 students in the evening shift. Those were the students who were refused admission in other colleges because of limited capacity, the decision was taken to enable maximum students complete F. Sc. Similarly, Khpal Kor Foundation also enrolled 50 girl students in three different colleges at Shahpur, Purn and Chakesar District Shangla. The aim of the initiative is to promote girls education in the lowest female literacy District Shangla.

A batch of 36 students from domestic child labor background families are continuing education with the support from Khpal Kor Foundation.

Another milestone of Khpai Kor Foundation is the purchase of 7 Kanal land for the establishment of Khpai Kor Village at Sherarai, Mingora Swat. The idea of Khpai Kor Village generated to provide the little flowers of Khpai Kor Foundation with a family style environment for better look after and brought up facilities. Khpai Kor Village will facilitate 100 orphans 10 in each flat to be served by an educated mother and an Aya/ Khala will also be available for cooking, cleaning and laundry services. The village will have own primary school, playing facility and recreational park. The little orphans will read there up to grade three and then will be bifurcated into the existing boys and girls campuses respectively.





Higher Education Program for destitute & talented students




Many talented students from poor families in the rural areas of Malakand Division are often deprived of higher education due to extreme poverty. For such students, Khpal Kor Foundation has taken initiative to support them in their studies after matriculation up to F.Sc level & university level with the core objectives of making them responsible and productive citizen of the country. The initiative is a great step towards making future of poor & talented students. The program is also likely to prevent vulnerable children & youth from indulging into criminality due to poverty and hence will minimize the risk of posing danger to the society at large.

Eligibility:

- 1) Secondary School Certificate (SSC) from any Government School.
- 2) Secured 80% or above marks in SSC (Science Group).
- 3) Belong to the poorest family of Malakand Division.
- 4) Agree to maintain A-1 grade on F.Sc level.

KKF offers for such students:

- 1) 2 years F.Sc level free education (Pre-Engineering/Pre-Medical) only.
- 2) Hostel Accommodation.
- 3) Free Mess.
- 4) Healthcare.
- 5) Daily Pocket Money.
- 6) Books & Stationery.
- 7) Uniform, Footwear and Clothes.
- 8) KKF is supporting such students after F.Sc if he/she gets admission on merit in professional institutions (in Pakistan) with interest free loan. The loan return policy is 5% to 10% of the salary after getting job.
- 9) Sports & Recreation Facility.

Orphans Sponsorship Program (OSP) (



Since its inception, Khpal Kor Foundation is running the orphan sponsorship programme in accordance with its mission. Started with sponsoring only five children, the programme has now turned into a huge success benefitting 568 orphan children from district Swat and other areas of Malakand division. Under the program the orphan children are provided with free of cost quality education from Nursery to FSc (Grade 12) along with standard boarding and health care facilities. The program is being funded by reputable organizations like Qatar Charity, UK Feed the Poor, Heart Canada, KidsRight and Pakistani diaspora community abroad.

Under the program orphan children are first registered through a registration form including their relevant and complete information which are verified through visits and then are granted admission with support from a sponsor. The concerned sponsor(s) are provided with regular updates about the academic, co-curricular and health status of their sponsored children on quarterly basis. The sponsors can pay the sponsorship cost either monthly, quarterly or yearly.

Khpal Kor Foundation Developments in the year 2016

Purchase of Land at Sheraral for Establishment of Khpal Kor Village. Khpal Kor Foundation succeeded in purchasing a peace of 7 Kanal land at Sheraral, Gulkada, Mingora Swat where Khpal Kor Village will be established for 100 orphan children. The village will have a primary School, recreational park and residential flats for 10 orphans to be served by an educated mother and an Aya/Khala to facilitate children with cooking and laundry services. Children at Khpal Kor Village will study up to class three and then will be bifurcated into the existing Girl and Boy campuses respectively. Initial construction work has kicked off and all-out efforts would be made to complete quality construction in the coming years.

Purchase of Land for Khpal Kor Model School Shangla Campus at Shahpur, District Shangla: As part of Khpal Kor Foundation expansion plan, Khpal Kor Foundation has purchased 20 Kanal land at Shahpur, Shangla where a magnificent building will be erected which will consist of a Higher Secondary Level School and boarding facilities for girl students.

Mr. Fazal Hakeem MPA PK 80 has very kindly approved 1 million Grant: Khpal Kor Foundation was granted PKR 1 million by Mr. Fazal Hakeem MPA for the construction of additional rooms at Girls Campus for orphan students.

(CDLD) Project funded for finishing work of hostel rooms at Khpai Kor Foundation Girls Campus: Community Driven Local Development Project (CDLD) a joint project of KP Government and the European Union funded for finishing work of hostel rooms at Girls campus. The finishing work has jointly been completed with 90% as CDLD share and 10% as Khpai Kor Foundation share.

Installation of Emergency Exit Stain: Keeping in view the need of emergency exist during Earthquake and other emergency, Khpal Kor Foundation installed a steef-made emergency stains at the main campus. The dormitories and auditorium will now be easy and prompt evacuation during earthquakes and other emergencies.

Naya Qadam Trust donated quilts for orphan childrens of Khpal Kor Foundation: Naya Qadam Trust donated best quality new vicki Quilts for orphan children of Khpal Kor children at the advent of winter season. The children were facilitated better with good juster bedding. The inmates are obliged to Naya Qadam Trust for such winter gifts.



Inayat Ullah

Educated and groomed at Khpal Kor Foundation, Inayat Ullah is a multitalented boy, who is, these days, doing BS (Hons) in Zoology from government post graduate Jahanzeb College in Swat. He is determined to achieve a Ph.D degree in Human Genomics. Having passion for music he also wants to perform as Musician and Singer.

On September 9, 1994 when his father died, his family fell into social and financial problems. Finding them helpless and alone their relatives, illegally, seized their property. At that hard time Inayatuallah was three years old, his sister was two and his younger brother was only eight months. Luckily, Khpal Kor Foundation admitted him and his brother as boarders where Inayat proved himself as one of the best and talented students.

Apart from being an intelligent and creative student he also earned fame of a very good singer of the school. Passing several milestones he was also declared as best host, speaker, writer, Naat Khwan, artist and best player of Table Tennis (Ping Pong). He earned several prizes and awards at District and Provincial levels. In academics, he stood 3rd in the BISE Swat SSC examination in the year 2008. He was also awarded presidential gold medal in national boy scouting.

In 2007, he represented Pakistan in the 21st world Scouts Jamboree at Chelmsford, UK. In 2011 he represented Pakistan in the 4th International Scouts Gathering, Intellectual Initiatives and Global Warming Conference at Sharjah, UAE. Mohammad Siyam, a brilliant student of Software Engineer.

Mohammad Siyam, a resident of Landaykas Mingora, was extremely excited when he was awarded a scholarship in the 4-year software engineering programme in Sri Lanka as it was his dream to become a software engineer. A brilliant student from grade one Siyam's life became troubled when his father, Muhammad Iqbal, who was a rickshaw driver, died of a heart attack in 2006. For him pursuing his dream of becoming software engineer became hazy. He describes his story. Till 2006 we had a normal life as my father arranged our livelihood along with providing good education but life got hard when he died in 2006 of heart attack. After my father's death, my step elder brother supported me in education to some extent but it was difficult for him to earn



livelihood for seven-member family and afford my education further. However, my brother could not afford my further education and my dream of becoming a software engineer was at stake. Mr. Siyam Says "Learning about our financial condition and my desire to get higher education, officials of the Khpal Kor Foundation, the local partner of ISRA-UK "Feed the Poor" gave me admission, free of cost, to pursue my education where I studied hard. Apart from getting high standard education here I learnt practical life oriented skills and English language through effective mentorship in KKF. Meanwhile, I came across a newspaper advertisement about the Government of Sri Lanka presidential scholarship for FSc students in the four-year Software Engineering programmer, advertised by Higher Education department. I applied for the said scholarship by the guidance of KKF and was successfully awarded the scholarship."

Kids Rights has provided financial assistance of € 50,000/- to the endowment fund of Khpal Kor Foundation. The amount granted by Kids Rights has been invested in a medicine business and the return/profit from the investment is spent on the education and boarding facilities of 25 orphan children. Khpal Kor Foundation with the financial assistance from Kids Rights has been supporting two Evening Colleges for Girls in district Shangla. These Colleges are providing education free of cost to 50 girl students at higher secondary/FSc level.

Realizing its dream to educate every orphan child in the region, Khpal Kor Foundation plans to expand its operation in other districts of Malakand Division. Similarly, a milestone has achieved by procuring 20 Kanal Land at Shahpur District Shangla where a magnificent building (Map and 3D design prepared) will be constructed to enable the students for have access to safe and quality education in their locality. State of the art campus will be established having a Model Higher Secondary level education and hostel facility, residential flats for the non-local faculty. In addition to this, a playground and polytechnic center will also be a part of the complex. Construction of the campus will be completed in phases, initial construction work is to be started soon, under which, phase-1 will be completed by the end of next year. The plan is to formally operationalise the campus in early 2018 to start its services.
